



WIIS Poland Regulations

1. Programme Women in International Security Poland (further on Programme or WIIS Poland) is part of activities carried out by Casimir Pulaski Foundation, called further on the Foundation.
2. Aims of WIIS Poland is to promote experts in the fields of security and foreign affairs, and to aid members of WIIS Poland in their careers using networking, professional development, and mentoring
3. To become a member of the Programme, one has to be an adult, natural person with full capacity to perform acts in law and not deprived of civil rights. The member can be Polish citizen or foreigner. Institutional member of WIIS Poland has to be a legal person with office in Poland.
4. To become a member of the Programme, one has to fill the registration form and pay membership fee up to 14 days after the approval of the registration. Confirmation of the bank transfers are to be sent to wiiis@pulaski.pl
5. Registration will be approved by the Director or Secretary General of the WIIS Poland within 10 days after presenting registration form.
6. Amount of the membership fee is set to 100 PLN per year for a professionally active person, and 30 PLN per year for a student. Amount of the membership fee for the institutional member is set to 1000 PLN per year. In addition to the confirmation of the bank transfer, a student is requested to send copy of her/his student I.D. card.
7. Payments for the membership ought to be made to a bank account no. 85 1500 1461 1214 6005 0539 0000 with the following details:
 - a. Name of the recipient – Casimir Pulaski Foundation
 - b. Title of the transfer – name and surname of the member and additional note: "membership fee in WIIS Poland"
8. When prolonging the membership in organization, the membership fee has to be paid the latest 14 days before the membership expires.
9. Decision-makers of the Programme are: Director and Secretary General of WIIS Poland.
